Dear Ranger Commander and Rangers,

As summer winds down, I hope you are all looking forward to an excellent East Fall Camporee at Camp Bashore. Hopefully weather will be better for us this year so that we might make use of the camps **entire** compliment of activities.

Last year we added the rifle range and archery range to our list of activities. Swimming in the lake as well as canoeing were also to be included. We hit a snag there because we were not able to secure two life guards to oversee the lake area. I have secured three life guards from the Boy Scouts so these two facilities will be available for us this year.

Once again, all meals will be served for those who do not want to bring and prepare their own food. Meals will be prepared for Saturday breakfast, lunch, dinner and Sunday brunch. **Friday and Saturday night snacks will be on your own** and will not be provided by the camp. However, the snack bar will be open and ready to serve your needs. Those Outposts who do not wish to eat camp food can bring their own food and prepare it. These Outposts will need to plan accordingly and provide quick, nutritional and complete meals for all their members.

Our theme again this year is **High Adventure**. A costume contest will be held with the top three High Adventure costumes receiving a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophies. Last year no one entered and the three trophies were just given away. I hope you all participate this year.

A uniform inspection of all Outposts will be given on Sunday morning, so make sure your boys bring their uniforms. **Each person who attends the Camporee will be issued a surprise giveaway.** I hope all were pleased with the flashlight give away last year.

The weekend's activities will include: 25 foot indoor climbing wall, 35 foot climbing tower, 35 foot rappelling tower, 250 foot zip line, high ropes course, low ropes course, rifle range, archery range, the camp's canoes, swimming, possible GPS Expedition activity, as well as lots of fun, age specific activities and games, and the opportunity to gather at the evening services and be lifted up spiritually during the great Christian fellowship council fires.

This will be a laid back weekend with no pressure on the boys to compete in any competitions. At the same time it will be a weekend packed with High Adventure Activities. There will definitely be something for everyone who attends, so start getting ready now! We will need men to volunteer for security, activity helpers, and outpost to serve as dinning room as well as shower room / bath room duties. Please come to the camp with a burden placed on your heart to serve. Last year's policy of see a need and fix that need worked out fantastically. So it will be in effect again this year.

### **Praise & Worship Team**

The cost for the weekend at the Camporee **with meals** will be \$40.00 if pre-registered by **August 27th**. The cost for the weekend at the Camporee **without meals** will be \$30.00 if pre-registered by **August 27th**; otherwise, the cost will be \$35.00 at the gate. If you do not pre-register your Outpost by **August 27th**, it will be assumed that you are bringing your own food and the camp **will not** provide food for your Outpost.

Upon arrival at camp, stop and register at the Camp Registration building to obtain your outpost packet that contains: **Camporee packet with Uniform Inspection Form, camp map, event patch, meal and activity wrist bands, and the give away**. Also, detailed information on campsites and the weekend's activities will be available, as well as a large map of the camp.

**Registration begins at 4:00 p.m on September 10th.**

The cost for Ranger Kids and their leaders coming for Saturday only will be \$23.00 if pre-registered by August 27th, otherwise, the cost will be \$25.00 at the gate. This includes lunch, supper, event patch, giveaway, and craft supplies, as well as other camp costs.

**Registration for Ranger Kids starts at 8:30 a.m. with activities to start at 9:30 a.m.**

Water will be available from the Camp water supply and storage tank that will provide water for drinking, washing and cooking purposes. We ask that each outpost burn all trash and haul away all other non-burnable garbage when they go home. There will be a camp store and snack bar open for everyone's use. There will be clothing items, food, snacks, drinks, candy, various camp items and more.

You can register online through the Penn-Del Web Site at: <http://www.pdrangers.org>. **All money** for pre-registration, whether online, e-mailed, or phone-in registration: **Must Be Received Within 5 Business Days after Registering to Qualify For The Discounted Price. A \$5.00 per person late fee will be added to all late payments.**

**Refunds:** Refunds will be given only if cancellation is received by August 3rd. Following that date, registration fees can be transferred to another individual at camp, but not refunded.

If you or someone in your Outpost has an e-mail address and would e-mail it to me, I will keep you posted of any updates that come out.

Please join us in prayer that boys will *find* the Lord and their hearts will be stirred to a closer walk and service to our Master Ranger. ## COMMANDER'S GUIDE

The staff is working hard to plan an exciting weekend for our boys and leaders. Our desire is for each one to experience God's blessing and our prayer is that He will touch everyone attending. If we can be of any assistance please ask any staff member.

### ***For everyone to enjoy the weekend we ask all attending to follow the following guidelines***

**LEADERS** from your Outpost will not be required to be with each age group if your Outpost does not have enough commanders. See Camp Coordinators for assistance. Fathers attending can accompany boys if approved by your church. We recommend the younger age boys have someone they are familiar with stay with them.

**KNIVES** are to be used only by Discovery Ranger, Adventure Ranger & Expedition Ranger boys that have a current Cut and Chop card. Knives are not to be worn on the uniform. No sheath knives are allowed. Outpost Commanders are responsible for their boys using, buying, or swapping knives.

**Paintball, Airsoft, or any other Weapon** will not be allowed on camp grounds, except those camp supplied. Any brought to camp will be held by security until the conclusion of the camp.

**FIRST AID** - All accidents and injuries must be reported to the First Aid Officer. **Our insurance will not cover accidents not reported.**

Any problems or difficulties should be reported to the Camp Coordinators. We want to make Camporee a rewarding experience. **QUIET TIMES** must be observed. Those violating the rules or disrupting the flow of the camp or services are subject to eviction from Camporee without refund.

There will be no unsupervised sports or activities of any kind. Contact sports such as tackle football are not permitted. Recreation time is scheduled in the activities.

Help will be needed with the group activities. Every commander should be involved somewhere. **REMEMBER**, we are here to minister to boys. We need your help to be effective.

Extra Camporee patches will be available from the Camp Store beginning at noon on Saturday.

Our desire is that everyone attending Camporee will receive a touch from the Lord and that His presence will be felt by all. This weekend may be the only time some boys may ever hear the gospel, so let's do our best to show them Christ.

**Please do not take offence to the following rules. They are necessary to maintain a safe atmosphere for all of us for the weekend.**

# CAMPOREE RULES

1. Please register as soon as possible upon arriving. **Permission slips and Medical Forms are required to be handed to the registration officer.**
2. **We will need a list of all attendees from you outpost for the day and weekend. This must be submitted at the time of registration.**
3. Upon registration every outpost will be assigned a specific camp duty to complete. **PLEASE, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
4. Move all vehicles to the assigned parking area immediately after setting up camp. No vehicles are to remain in campsites unless the Camp Commander grants permission.
5. **ABSOLUTELY** no rock throwing, alcoholic beverages, smoking, cursing, or fireworks permitted. Violators will be asked to leave the grounds and registration will not be refunded.
6. The Registration office acts as a place for registration as well as the security office. If there are questions, concerns, or an emergency, help can be found there. It is for official business only and is off limits as a hang out.
7. Use only restrooms assigned to Men. Ladies will be present in camp and will be using restrooms assigned to Women.
8. Don't make a mess in the restrooms. Keep the facilities clean. We **all** must use them for the entire weekend.
9. Keep campsites clean. Lodges have attendance fire limits. We must follow the camp rules on these in order for our insurance to cover us.  
**Upper Friends Pavilion:** 40 person capacity  
**Brown Pavilion:** 22 person capacity  
**Lower Friends Pavilion:** 32 capacity  
Outpost that have Ranger Commanders or Rangers attending that are over the set limits must set tents up outside these structures for their housing.
10. Do not venture into areas of the campground not being used for the Camporee. Commanders, know where your boys are at all times. Boys, **no hiking the woods** after lights out hours
11. Fires are to be attended at all times. Use available fire rings at their established locations.
12. Attend all functions and be on time. **Commanders and boys may not remain in camps during council fire services. Council fires are mandatory unless permissions have been granted.**
13. In the event of severe storm or emergency conditions, follow the direction of security or emergency personnel. The Dinning Hall is the main location for protection.

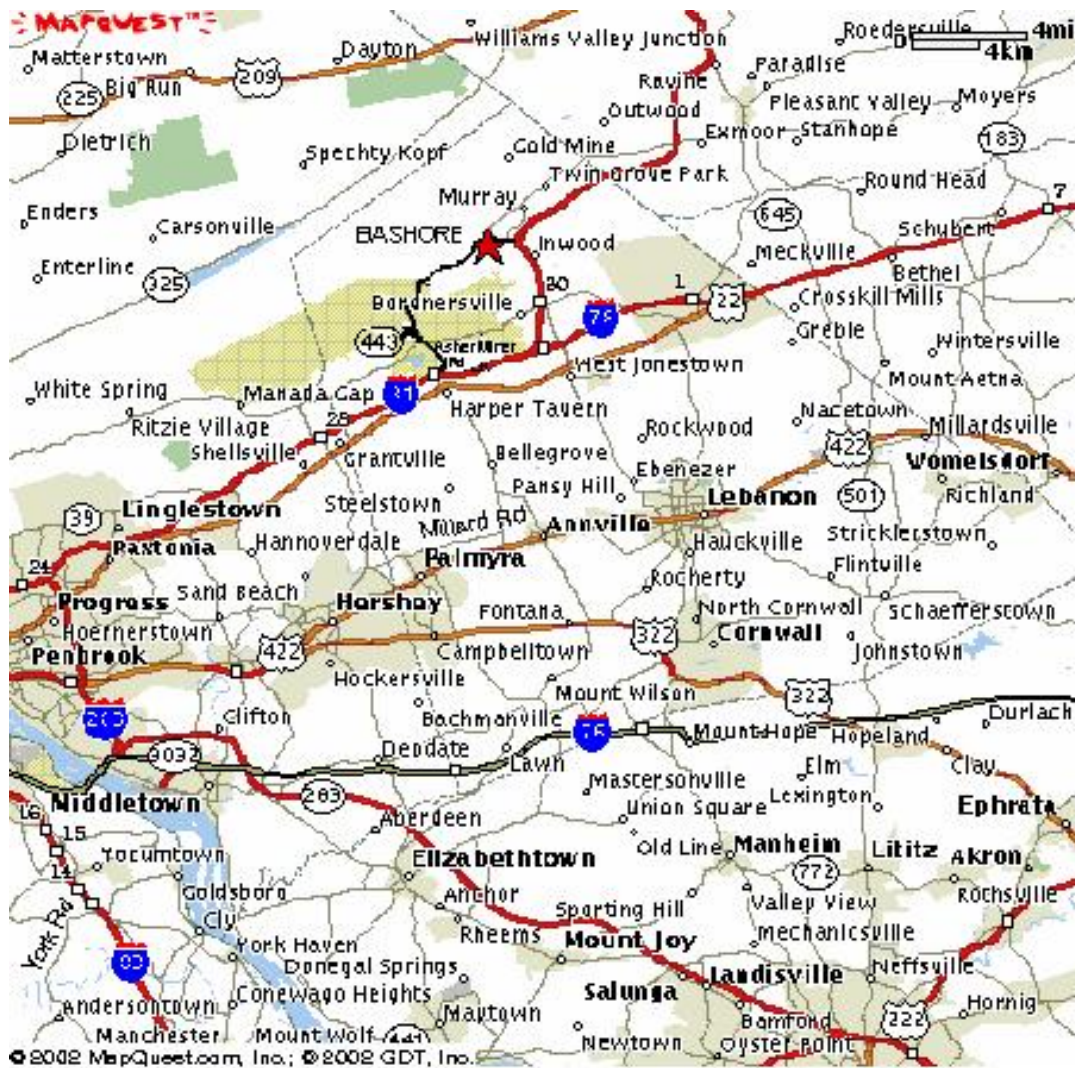

## DIRECTIONS TO CAMP BASHORE:

The camp can be reached by several different routes and is easily accessible from major highways and interstates. **To use MAPQUEST, type in: 160 Moonshine Road, Jonestown, PA 17038 for your destination information.**

**From ROUTE 72** - take Route 72 North through the city of Lebanon. After passing through the city, remain on Rt. 72 for approximately 14 miles. Pass through the towns of Ebenezer, Jonestown, and Lickdale. After passing through the intersection at Lickdale begin looking for signs for Rout 443 West. This will be a left-hand turn onto Moonshine Road. Follow Rt. 443 West (Moonshine Road) for 2 miles, camp is located on the Left hand side.

**From ROUTE 934-** This road can be accessed via Route 322 or 422. Take route 934 North through the town of Annville, continue to follow North towards Fort Indiantown Gap Military Reservation. When you go through the Route 81 interchange, remain in the left lane and look for the intersection of Asher Miner Road. (There is a gas station called Funck's Mini Mart & Restaurant on the right.) At Asher Miner Road, turn left and follow to next stop sign. Proceed straight ahead onto Rt. 443 East. Follow route 443 East (also called Moonshine Road) for approximately 4 miles, camp entrance is on the right side. If for some reason you miss the Asher Miner road, keep going straight through Fort Indiantown Gap, and into the town of Lickdale. At the traffic light, turn Left and proceed as if following the Route 72 directions.

**From ROUTE 81- NORTH OR SOUTH-** Take exit 90 (Lickdale / Lebanon Exit) at the bottom of the ramp, follow signs to Route 72 at main intersection of Lickdale. Turn Left onto 72 North. After 4 miles, you'll see signs that indicate Route 72 ends, and route 443 intersects. Take route 443 West (left hand turn) this road is also known as Moonshine Road. Follow Rt. 443 West (Moonshine Road) for 2 miles, camp is located on the Left hand side.

**From ROUTE 76- PA Turnpike-** Take the Lebanon exit and at the top of the exit ramp (traffic light) turn Left onto route 72 North. Route 72 and 322 split. If you stay in the left lane, follow directions for 934 North. If you get into the Right lane, follow the directions for Route 72 North.
